Typically, pledge receipts during the month of January are slow and this year was no different. Receipts were less than in 2024 and our forecast. Unrestricted cash at the end of the month was sufficient to cover expenses only for about 2 weeks – pretty low. It improved in February.

The Church’s Endowment Fund unanimously approved a gift of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to PACE for Girls, Inc. (This Fund is separate from our Operating Fund.) PACE provides special instruction and guidance counseling to young ladies not succeeding in public schools. Its primary operation is in Lakeland, but outreach programs function in several schools in the County, including Bartow. The Church’s gift is restricted to the programs conducted in Bartow.
